Summary Annual Report

For Professional Alternative 401(k) Plan

This is a summary of the annual report for Professional Alternative 401(k) Plan, Employer Identification Number 04-3238604, Plan No. 001 for the period January 01, 2022 through December 31, 2022. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided through a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$349,744. These expenses included \$22,992 in administrative expenses and \$282,261 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries and \$44,491 in other expenses. A total of 99 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$5,845,211, as of December 31, 2022 compared to \$7,228,696 as of January 01, 2022. During the plan year, the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of (\$1,383,485). This decrease includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of (\$1,033,741), including employer contributions of \$0, employee contributions of \$431,616, other contributions of \$5,079, and losses from investments of (\$1,470,436).

Information Regarding Plan Assets

The U.S. Department of Labor's regulations require that an independent qualified public accountant audit the plan's financial statements unless certain conditions are met for the audit requirement to be waived. This plan met the audit waiver conditions for the plan year beginning 2022 and therefore has not had an audit performed. Instead, the following information is provided to assist you in verifying that the assets reported on the Form 5500 were actually held by the plan.

Fidelity Management Trust Company is a regulated financial institution and as of end of the plan year the plan held assets totaling \$5,845,211. The plan receives year-end statements from this regulated financial institution that confirms the above information.

Plan participants and beneficiaries have a right, on request and free of charge, to get copies of the financial institution year-end statements and evidence of the fidelity bond.
